



Announcement from Pak Khlong San Metropolitan Police Station.

Subject: Announcement of the implementation of the Anti-Bribery Policy and the No Gift Policy regarding the acceptance of gifts, presents, or other benefits in the performance of duties for the fiscal year ๒๐๒๖

According to the Procedures for Prevention and Investigation Act B.E. ๒๕๖๑, Chapter ๖, Conflict of Interest, Section ๑๒๘, it is prohibited for any official to accept any qualifications or other benefits that can be calculated in monetary terms from access to any property or other benefits that are rightfully theirs. The first part of the law issued under the authority of the Act presents qualifications or other benefits in a ethical manner based on research and known amounts, prevention and criticism, recommendations on national administration plans, administration and central authority, personal and misconduct. Key issues in determining the form of prevention strategies include requiring section heads, control heads, or supervisors to have measures to create an organizational culture of prevention and consideration of criticism and misconduct, and to ensure honest and accountable administration. Negligence in taking action will be considered a disciplinary offense or a criminal offense.

The Metropolitan Police Pak Khlong San database requires all police officers to strictly adhere to the Anti-Bribery Policy (No Gift Policy), which includes not accepting gifts, presents, or any other benefits, for the fiscal year ๒๐๒๖ of the Metropolitan Police Pak Khlong San. To reinforce the authority of commanders under Police Order No. ๑๒๑๒/๒๕๖๗ dated October ๑, ๒๐๒๔, to closely monitor all subordinates and provide expert opinions on violations of measures to verify the correctness of penalties in order to build an organization that provides fairness to the public and is free from all forms of bribery.
